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



Improving fishers' practices with captured protected species

Achievements:

• **Training to over 2,150 people,** including fishers, observers, and fishery managers in 12 countries in America and Europe.

- In the Mediterranean, we've assessed hook injuries and post-capture mortality on longline vessels.
- First research studies on the incidence of decompression in sea turtles captured by trawl (100%) and related post-release mortality (25-30%) (Parga et al. 2020).


