The EU Green Deal and the accompanying Chemicals Strategy for Sustainability Towards a Toxic-Free Environment present bold action points that reflect the challenge associated with persistent and mobile substances.

ZeroPM interlinks **Prevention**, **Prioritization** and **Removal** to protect the environment and human health from persistent and mobile substances. The goal of this workshop is to identify and discuss stakeholder advantages from diverse sectors for prioritizing persistent and mobile substance groups for risk governance.

Presentations and discussions will be held by experts and ZeroPM consortium members, featuring their latest results about how to interlink substance grouping, hazard, and risk assessment approaches. Topics of relevance include safe and sustainable by design, policy, market transition, transformation products, chemical data transparency, monitoring approaches, exposure assessment, new approach methodologies (NAMs) and water treatment methods.

Registration will open in May and spaces are limited. Registration will cost approximately €150 to cover refreshments, lunches, and the evening program, which will feature an excursion to Bauhaus Dessau.
