Vision and Aims	Designing better R&I calls for projects and ideas thanks to citizens' contributions
	and in turn supporting only R&I products and services that are aligned with
	citizens values, needs and expectations
Target Audience	Citizens
Key Features	In June 2022, a face-to-face Citizens' Jury engaged 24 Lombardy citizens - selected
	according to specific socio-demographics criteria - to learn, discuss and deliberate
	during two Saturdays about regional Responsible Smart Mobility, a key theme of
	the Lombardy Smart Specialization Strategy (S3).
	At the end, Jurors provided the Lombardy Region with specific recommendations
	on how to insert responsibility issues like privacy and profiling, digital and
	economic inclusion, and accessibility in the preparation of a Lombardy Region call
	for projects on local mobility data-driven services (launched in Autumn 2022).
	Citizens' recommendations have been inserted as requirements for applicants to
	be considered in their project proposals and, of course, in the execution of the
	winning projects.
Achievements &	A Citizens Jury and other forms of deliberation can meaningfully inform
Learnings	policymakers to design better operational R&I policies (i.e. call for R&I projects or
	ideas). Useful criteria for selecting projects can emerge from this approach to
	ensure that the final outcomes generated by the funded project are, from the
	outset, aligned with societal values and needs. In fact, thanks to the citizens'
	contributions, selected R&I projects will be "responsible by-design" since they
	will include citizens' opinions on societal responsibility issues when designing and
	shaping project results.
	This approach can be relevant especially for a call for projects/ideas dealing with
	potential controversial technologies (i.e. AI, genome editing, etc.), in which the
	inclusion of societal perspectives is fundamental.
