





PSF Georgia: Context and focus areas

2015: "Policy Mix **Peer Review** of the Georgian STI system"

2016: **Letter of Aleksandre Jejelava**, Minister of Education and Science of Georgia, requesting PSF support to the implementation of key PMPR recommendations

2017-2018: PSF advice and concrete recommendations on **3 focus areas**:

- 1) Support in identification of promising research fields
- 2) Measures for narrowing the gap between research and industry/business
- 3) Proposal for the performance-based funding of research entities

Collection of background data and reports Engagement of all relevant stakeholders

In-depth ANALYSIS and REVIEW sessions

Background analysis
'Self-assessment by host country

First country visit – week of 4-8 Dec Second country visit – week of 5-9 Feb

REPORTING

Discussion of draft report with national authorities of the host country

Final report and recommendations

Presentation to all relevant stakeholders
