In-depth assessments of a country's R&I system carried out by a panel of experts and leading to concrete recommendations to the national authorities on reforms necessary to strengthen their R&I system








# **PSF Specific Support to countries**


Provides a set of concrete recommendations on how to tackle a specific R&I policy challenge and how to implement the accompanying reforms





## **PSF Mutual Learning Exercises**

Focussed on specific/ operational R&I challenges of interest to several volunteering countries, and draw on a hands-on project-based exchange of good practice.





## The MLE on International Cooperation will

#### 1. Address a specific and common R&I challenge

• Focus on policy challenge that is of interest to several volunteering countries

#### 2. Identify good practices, lessons learned and success factors

• Using robust evidence about impacts of the measures and the contextual factors

#### 3. Promote Policy learning

• MS learn from each other exploring specific questions and from experiences in other countries

#### 4. Provide high level advice and assistance from external experts

 Policy options and tools for fine-tuning or implementing change in the design of the current policy system

#### 5. Follow a Modular approach

Workshops, Country visits, etc



# **PSF** participation per country




All EU Member States have participated in at least one PSF activity so far!


